Update on Dental Implants: Oral and Systemic Considerations

Course Description

This course will take an in-depth look at three main areas. First, new information assessing the best treatment plan for a single missing tooth will be presented. Second, oral-systemic links with a focus on the relationship between osteoporosis and oral cavity since a number of possible interactions exist between the jaw bones and systemic bone activity. Third, dental implant companies are continually presenting the practitioner with new implant surfaces to "enhance" osseointegration. The question arises whether these surface modifications really do make a difference.



About the Speaker

Dr. Koka is a professor of dentistry and chair of the department of dental specialties at the Mayo Clinic in Rochester, Minnesota. As a consultant in the Division of Prosthodontics at Mayo Clinic, Dr. Koka maintains a four-day a week practice limited to fixed, implant and removable prosthodontics. Dr. Koka received his DDS degree in 1989 from the University of Michigan, the MS in prosthodontics degree in 1991 from the University of Michigan, and the PhD degree from the University of Nebraska in 1999. He has received numerous teaching awards from dental students and his scholarly work has been published in a wide array of international journals and books. Dr. Koka is a Diplomate of the American Board of Prosthodontics and a member of a variety of dental professional organizations. Born and reared in England, his hobbies include playing soccer, cricket, and golf as well as being an active runner.
