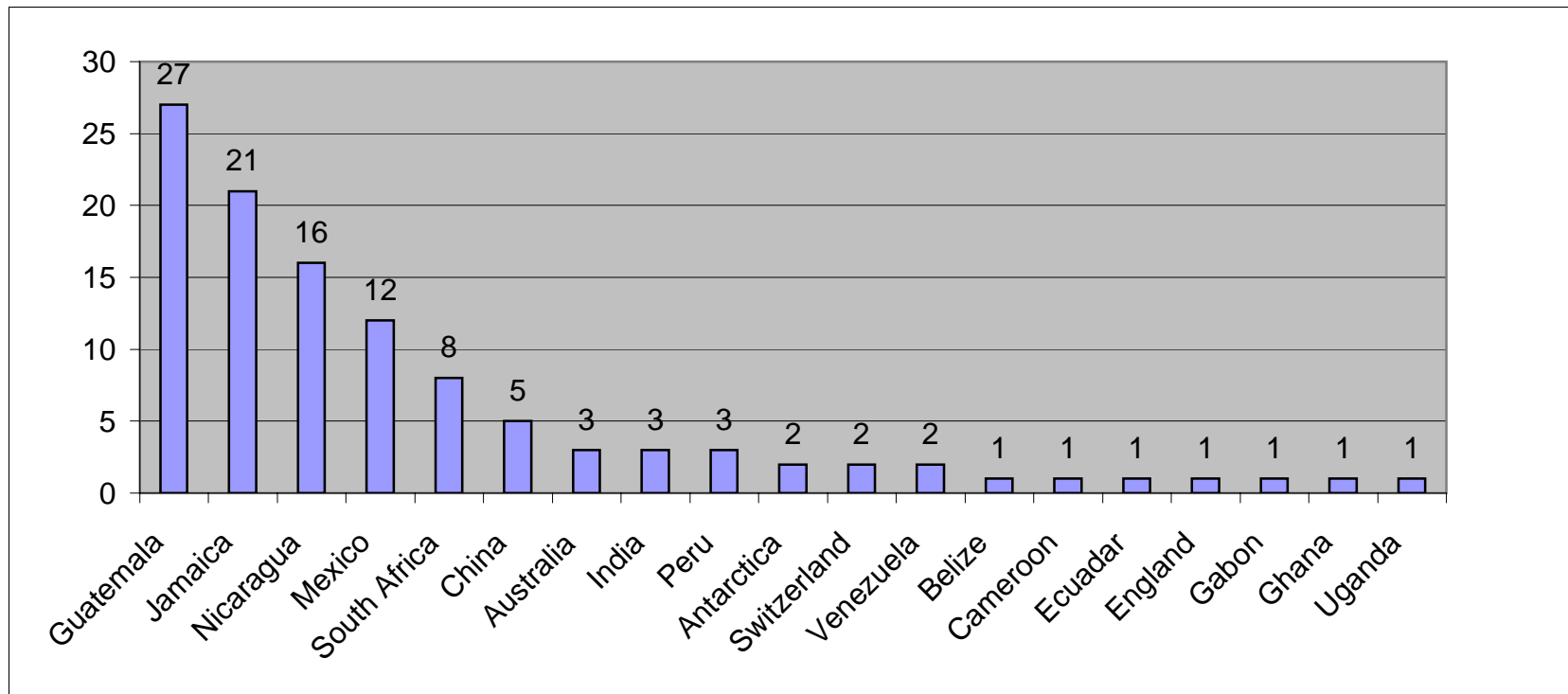


# UNMC Students' *Global Health Experiences*

June 2007 – May 2008

From June 2007 through May 2008, **111 UNMC students** participated in clinical or pre-clinical international medical/health experiences, ranging from one to eight weeks long. Of this total, 91 students were from the College of Medicine, 3 from the School of Allied Health Professions, 8 from the College of Nursing, 8 from the College of Pharmacy, and one from the College of Public Health. *Twenty one percent of the 2008 COM class participated in one or more global health electives during the senior year.*

- 13 students participated in a medical service trip to Nicaragua (COM, CON, COP)
- 3 students participated in a medical service trip to the Texas/Mexico border (COM, CPH)
- 19 different countries visited
