**International Health Elective  
Baillie Grant Application**

This grant is provided by E. Eugene Baillie, MD, a UNMC College of Medicine graduate, Class of 1967, and Virginia Baillie, UNMC Division of Medical Technology, Class of 1965. Their intent is that the grant be provided to a student or students who are interested in providing medical assistance to underserved areas of the world, helping people who have little or no access to medical care. Preference is given to students serving at Christian-affiliated health facilities and/or to students who express a personal Christian-based philosophy.

Third and fourth year medical students are eligible to apply. The amount of the grant ranges from \$250 to \$1000, depending on the number of awards given. Third year students who receive the award will have it applied to a fourth year elective. The preferred rotation length is four or more weeks. Awards will be considered for rotations shorter than four weeks if the applicant provides written justification.

**Deadline for the application submission is 29 September 2003.** Applications will be reviewed by Family Medicine and International Studies & Programs, as well as by Dr. and Mrs. Baillie, who will make the final selection. Award notification will occur in October 2003.

Award recipients will be required to submit a typed report about their international experience within one month of their return. The report will be made available to other students to read who may be planning an international health experience. The grant will be awarded upon satisfactory completion of the student's elective and report submission.
