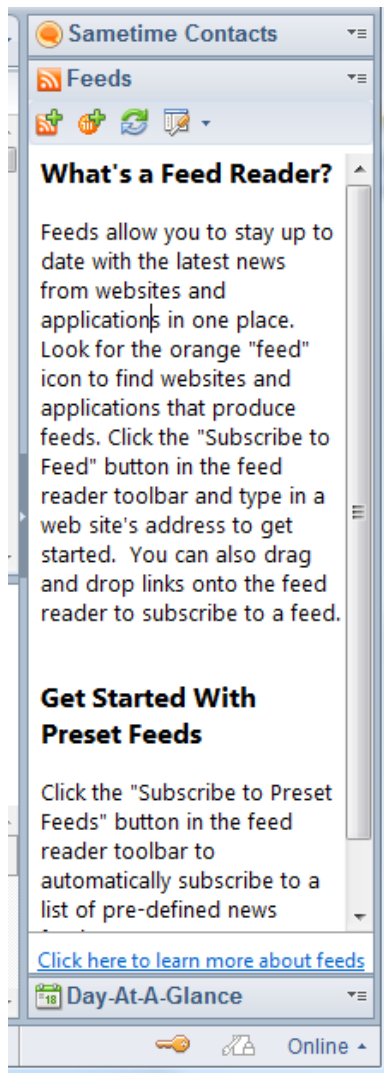


What's an RSS Feed Reader?



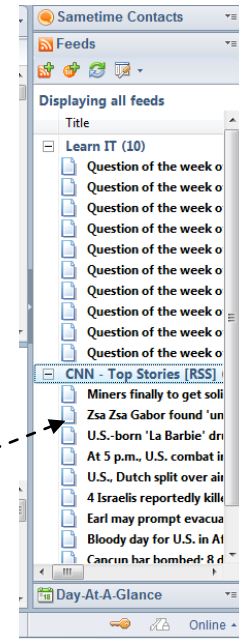
Open the Notes Sidebar

Open the Notes sidebar one of two ways:

- Click View > Right Sidebar
- Click along the right side of your Notes window to expand the Sidebar

Adding feeds to the reader

You can tell if a Web site or blog syndicates its content by the feed icons displayed on the site, usually on the front page. When you find a Web site or blog that has a feed to which you want to subscribe, subscribe to it using the choices below:

- Open a Web page that contains the feed that you want, click the feed icon, for example "RSS Feed" and drag it to the feeds list in your Feeds sidebar panel
- Open a Web page that contains the feed that you want and drag the URL from your browser's address bar to the feeds list in the Feeds sidebar pane.
- Click **Subscribe to Feed** in the Feeds toolbar and enter the URL of the feed to which to want to subscribe.

Note: If you clicked **Subscribe to Feed**, type in the URL of the Web site that hosts the feed to which you want to subscribe, or the specific Web address of a feed. If the site offers more than one feed, a list of feeds appears in the dialog box for you to choose from.

All of these actions open the **Add New Subscription** dialog box, in which you can set the following parameters for the feed that you are adding:

- feed name to display in your feeds list
- frequency with which the feed source is checked for updates
- length of time to keep feed entries visible in your feeds list
- length of time to keep feed entries visible in your feeds list
