Linking articles from EBSCO into Blackboard

Full-text articles found in library databases can be linked into the Blackboard course space. Due to the various licenses of these databases, **please check with the library if you want to post the article for more than one semester.**



Many full-text articles can be found within the **EBSCO** databases. You can identify these databases from this symbol.

To link an article from an **EBSCO** database, follow these steps:

1. Find the full-text article you want to link and click on the title:
