



Linking articles from *Science Direct* journals into Blackboard

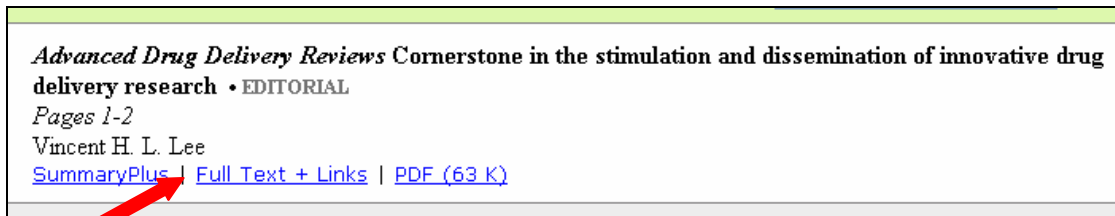
Full-text articles found in library databases can be linked into the Blackboard course space. Due to the various licenses of these databases, **please check with the library if you want to post the article for more than one semester.**



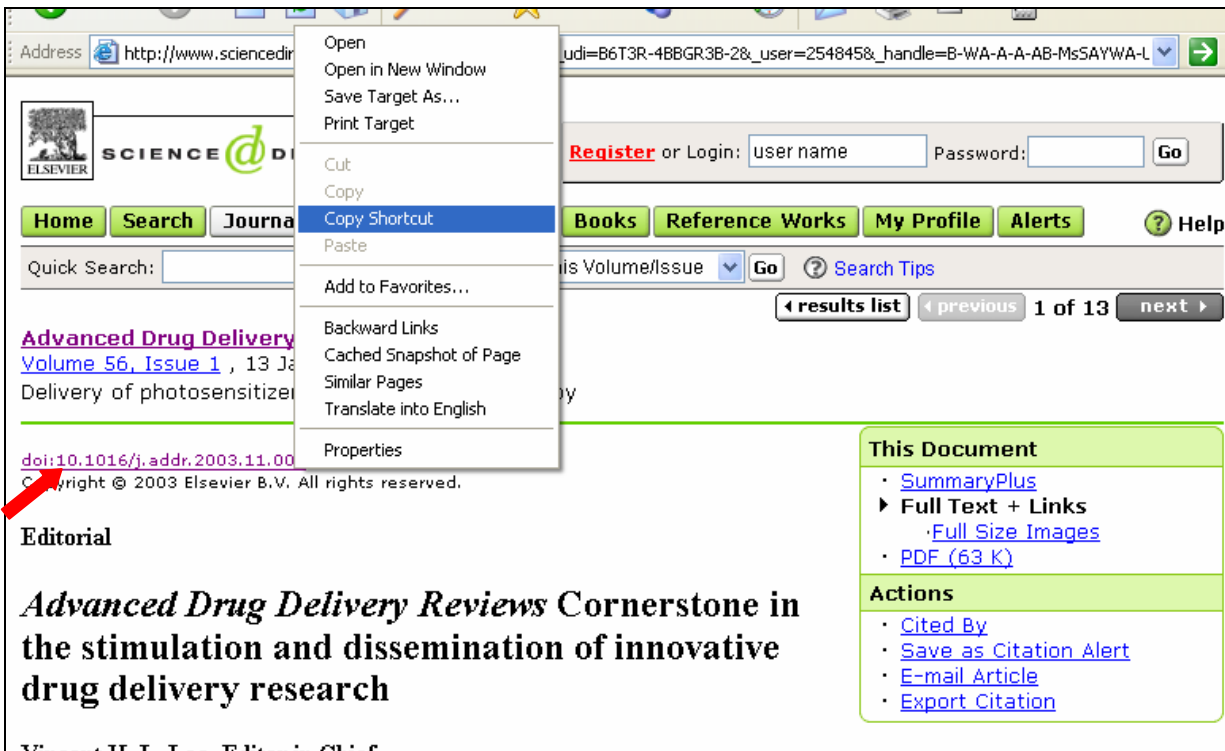
Science Direct journals can be identified by this symbol.

To link an article from the *Science Direct* journals, follow these steps:

1. Find the full-text article you want to link and click on the **Full Text + Links** link:



2. After the article has been opened, right click on the DOI address and select **Copy Shortcut** from the menu.



3. Paste the link into Word:

<http://dx.doi.org/10.1016/j.addr.2003.11.002>

4. Proxy server: Important step!

In order for students to access the link from off campus, the proxy server address must accompany the article link. Add the following URL before the article link with no additional spaces:

<http://library1.unmc.edu:2048/login?url=>

Final product:

<http://library1.unmc.edu:2048/login?url=http://dx.doi.org/10.1016/j.addr.2003.11.002>

5. Now, paste the link into Blackboard as you would any other link.

6. Test your links!

Note: Some Science Direct journals require the end-user to click an additional link to access the full-text article. Once you click your article link, you may see a page with the symbol below. You will need to direct your students to click that symbol to access the full-text.
