Award

Up to \$40,000 for the period July 1, 2009, to June 30, 2010

- Indirect costs are unallowable
- Salary support for the Principal Investigator (PI) or other faculty on full-time appointments is unallowable
 - UNMC requires an investigator to commit effort to a project for which s/he will serve as PI. To minimize cost-share, SPAdmin recommends committing no more than ten percent (10%).

Behavioral science	1 original (paper-clipped) PLUS 6 copies (stapled) OR 6 CDs* PLUS Appendix (if applicable)
