

Training

The inpatient training occurs primarily at three different sites: The Nebraska Medical Center, the VA Medical Center and Omaha Children's Hospital. There is also the opportunity to participate in off-site rotations in both departments, ranging from more rural Nebraska rotations to International rotations in South Africa or Spain.

Continuity Clinic currently occurs in three different settings, Turner Park Internal Medicine Clinic, UNMC Pediatrics Clinic and Baker Place Combined Med-Peds Clinic, all of which are described below.
