GRADUATE COURSES APPROVED FOR TRANSFER BY THE GRADUATE AFFAIRS COMMITTEE

Students completing any of the approved courses for transfer listed below, must request an original transcript to be sent to the UNMC Graduate Nursing Program immediately upon completion of the course. The student should write a letter to the Associate Dean requesting that the course be accepted for transfer. When this is received, the course will be added to the student's plan of study. If a course is not listed on these pages, the student should talk to their advisor first about requesting a transfer. The student will need to give their advisor a current course description of the course they want to transfer. In some instances additional material, such as a syllabus or student project, may be required. A course instructor will review the material and send a recommendation to the Graduate Affairs Committee. Following Graduate Affairs approval, a recommendation is submitted to the Dean of the Graduate College for final approval. All courses presented for transfer must meet the Graduate College policy that all coursework for the master's degree must be completed within 5 years prior to graduation.
