

# Pediatrics Clerkship Curriculum

The UNMC Pediatrics Clerkship uses the standardized curriculum developed by the [Council on Medical Student Education in Pediatrics](#). This material is available to UNMC students completing the Pediatrics clerkship through our Blackboard site.

The pediatric clerkship experience introduces students to the field of pediatric medicine. It emphasizes those aspects of general pediatrics important for all medical students and will provide a foundation for those students who elect to further study the health care of infants, children and adolescents. Students will have the opportunity to participate in the clinical activities of both general and subspecialty pediatric services, but the emphasis in all services is placed on basic issues and common illnesses important for the education of the general physician.

When students are formally enrolled in the Pediatrics Clerkship, they will have access to additional curricular materials on Blackboard.
