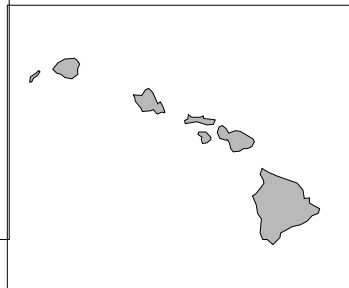
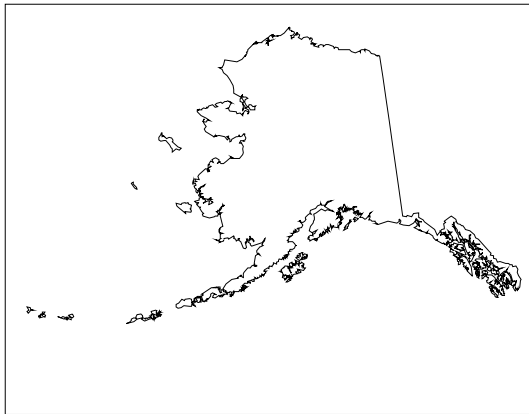
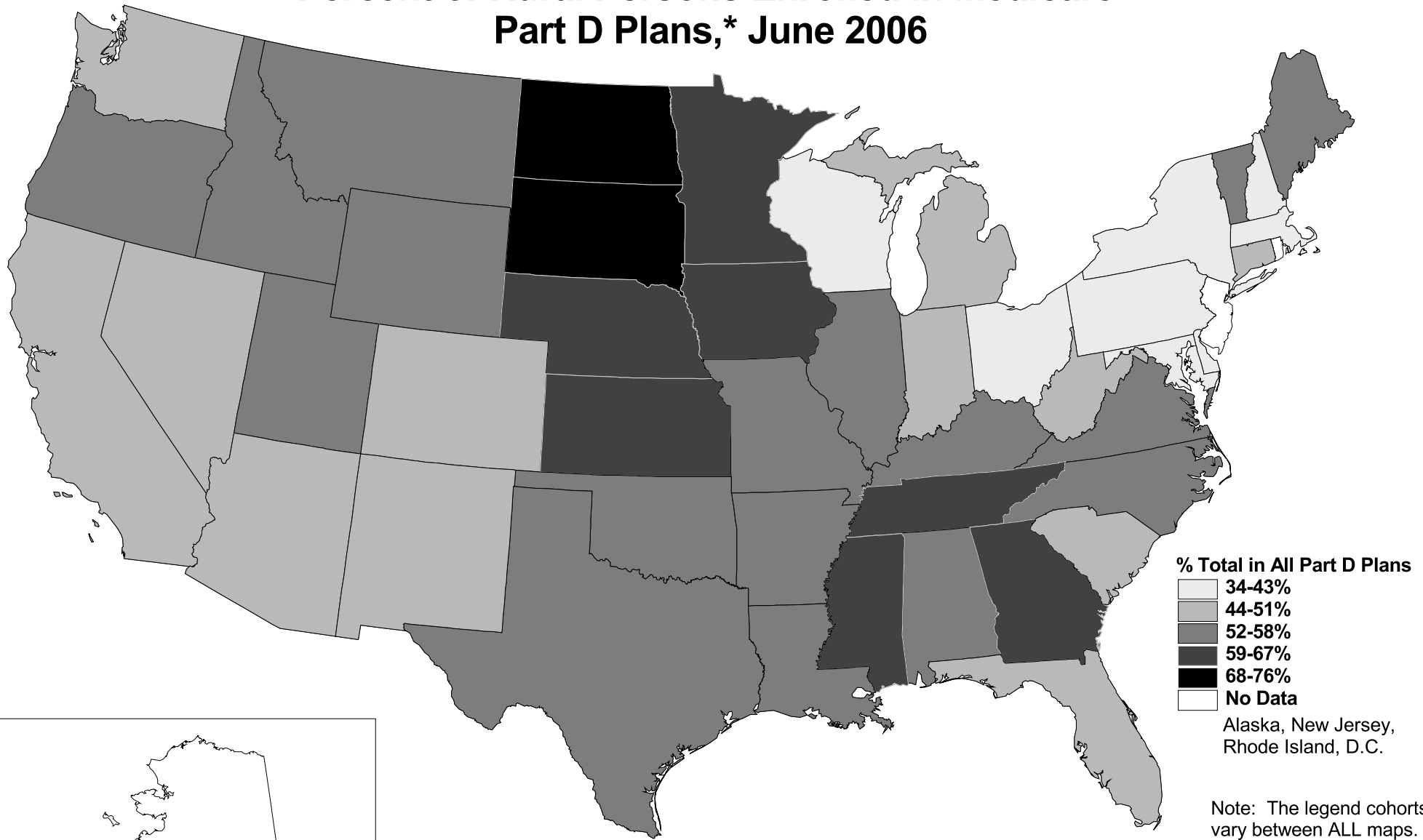


Percent of Rural Persons Enrolled in Medicare Part D Plans,* June 2006

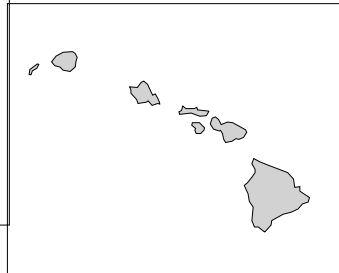
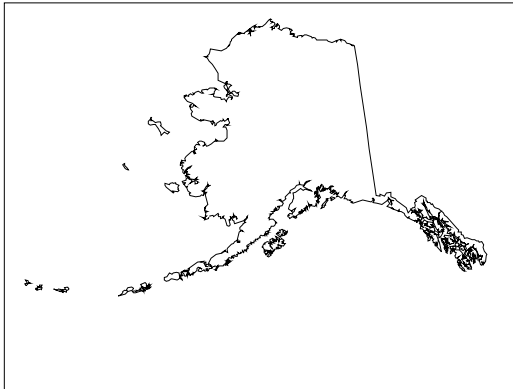
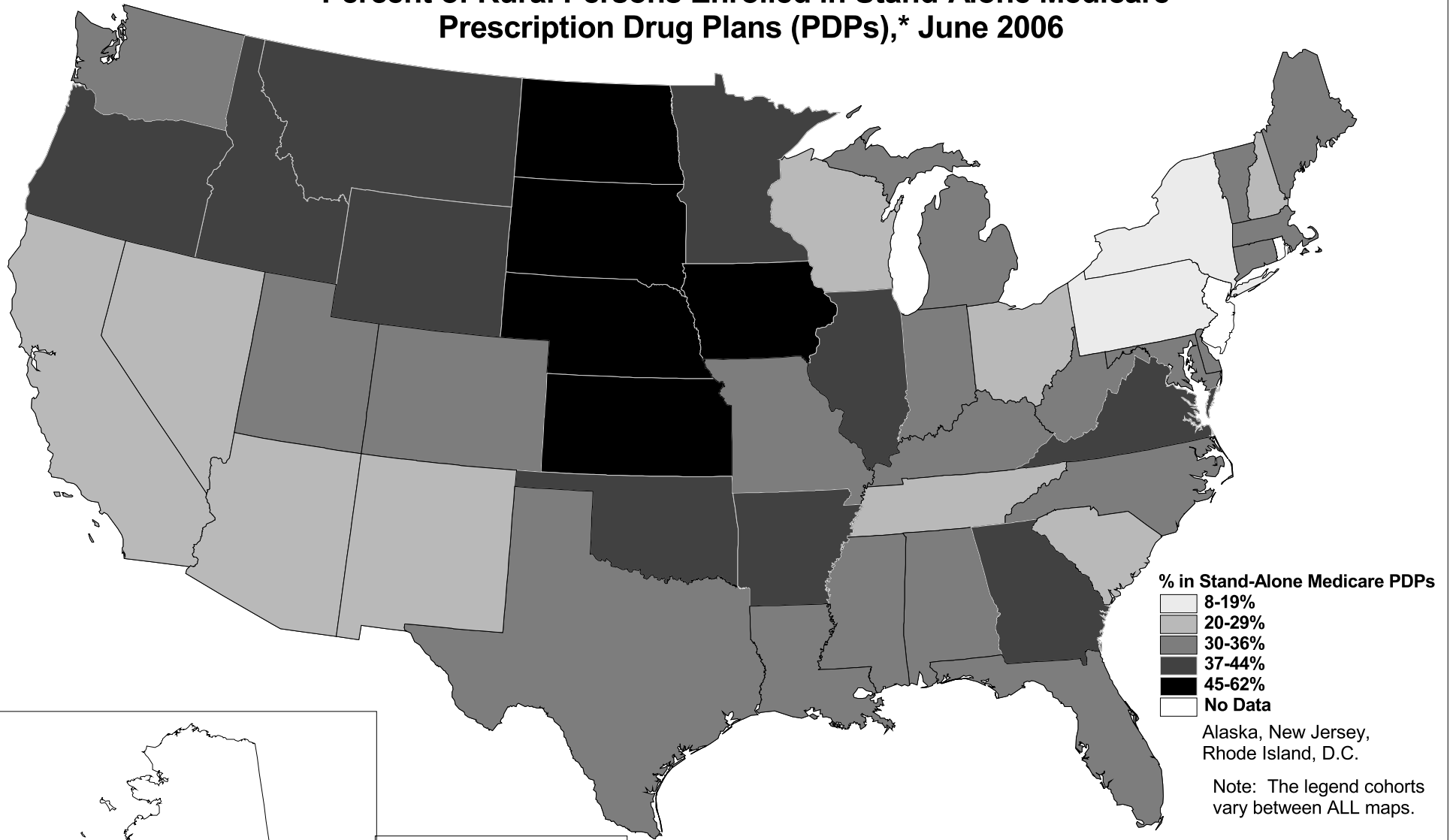

Percent of Rural Persons Enrolled in Stand-Alone Medicare Prescription Drug Plans (PDPs),* June 2006

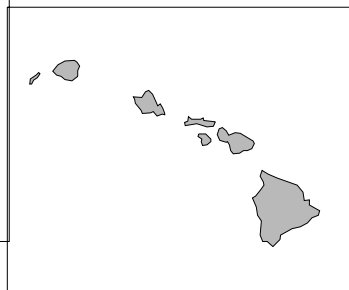
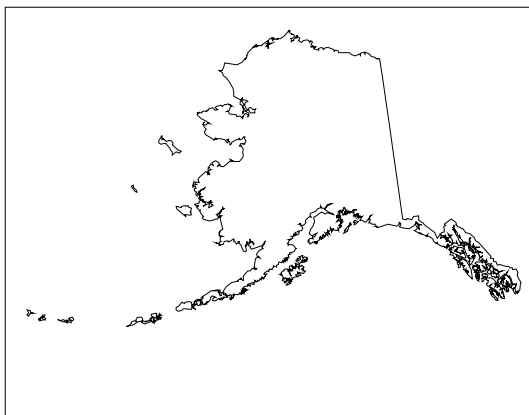
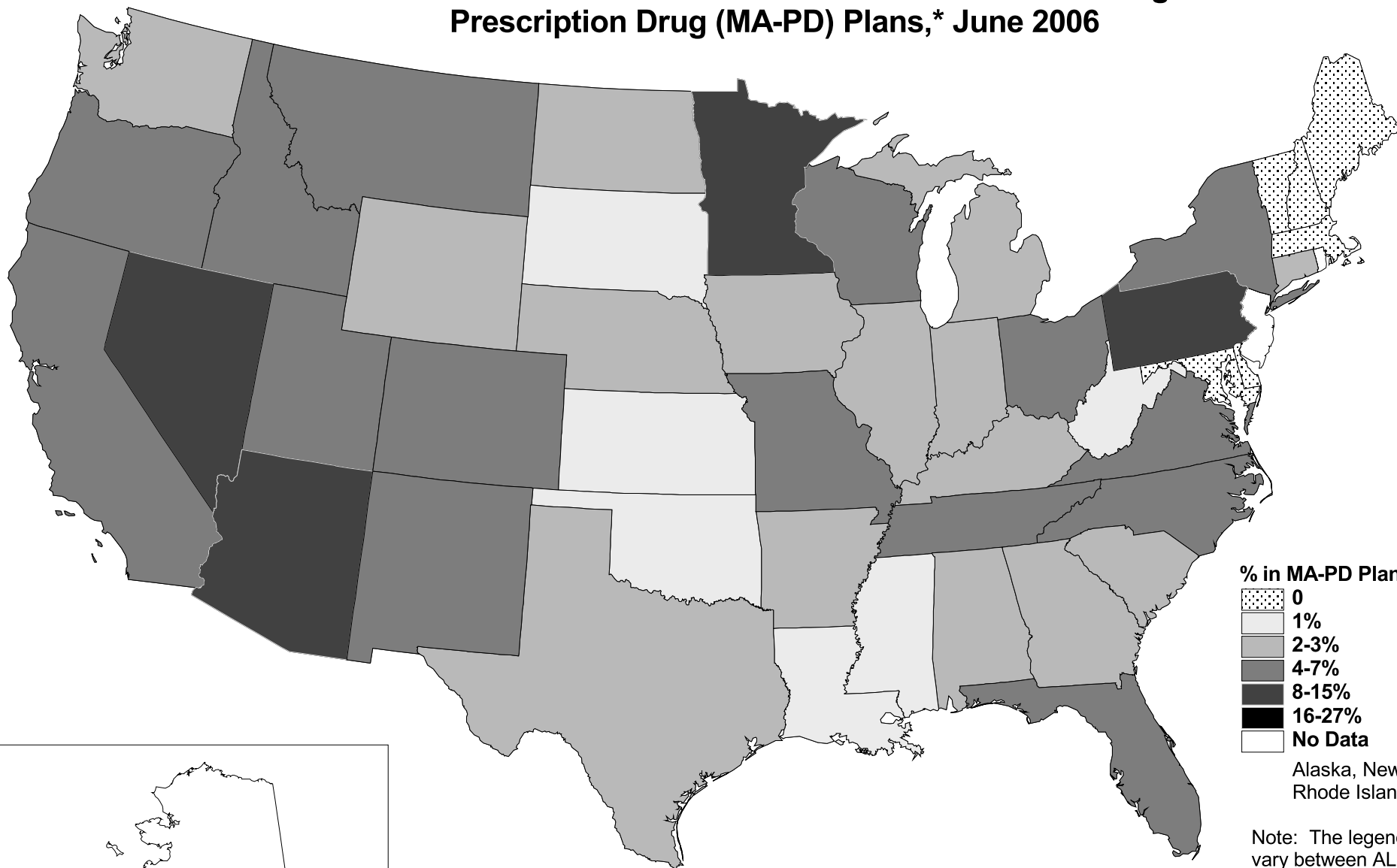

Percent of Rural Persons Enrolled in Medicare Advantage Prescription Drug (MA-PD) Plans,* June 2006

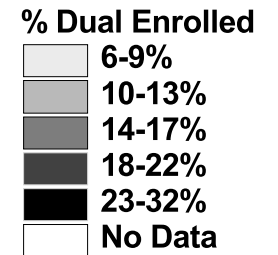
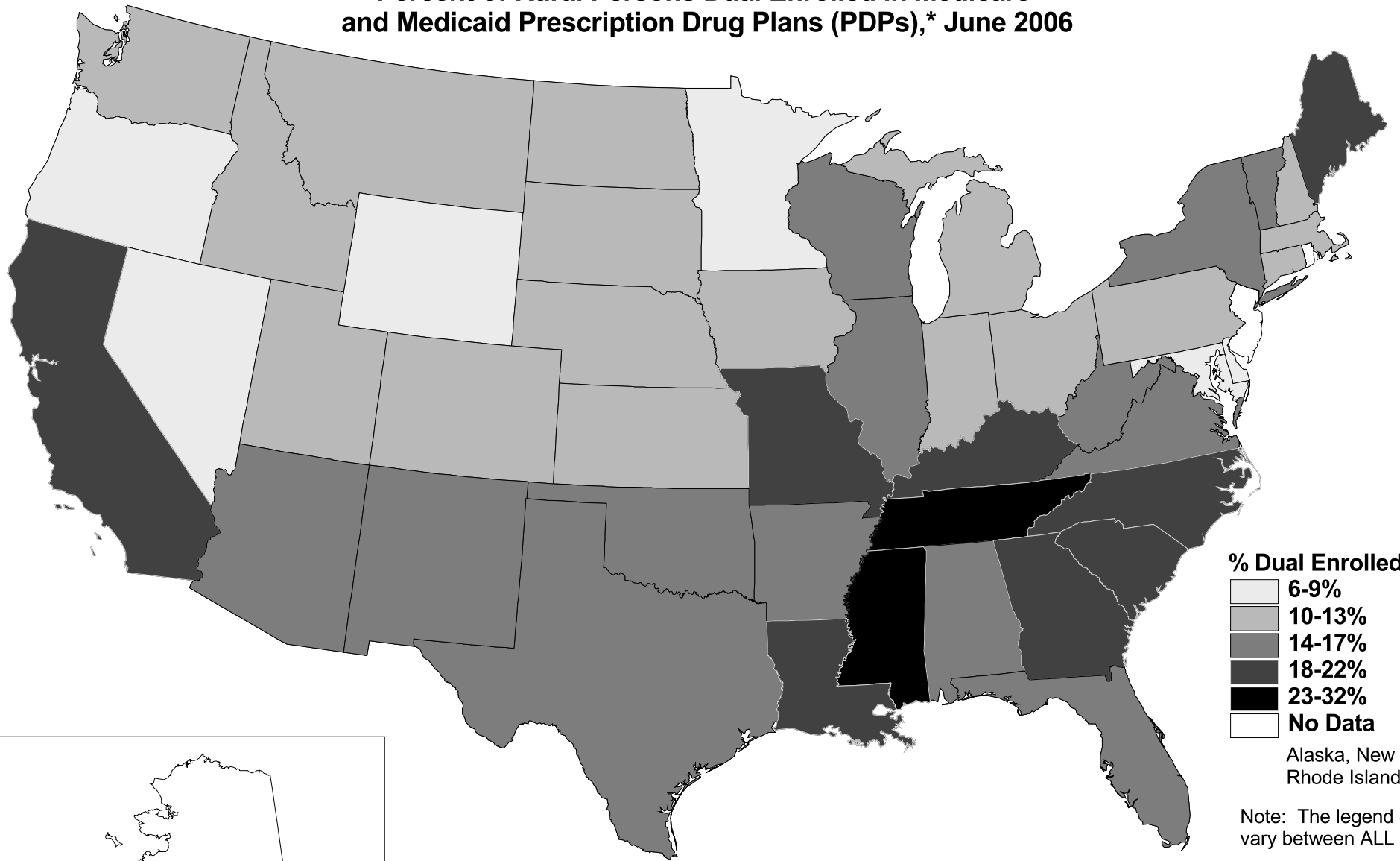

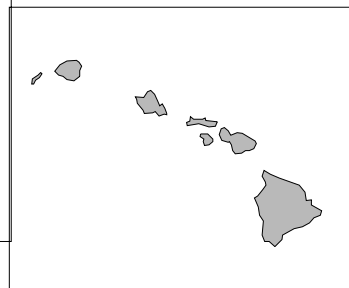
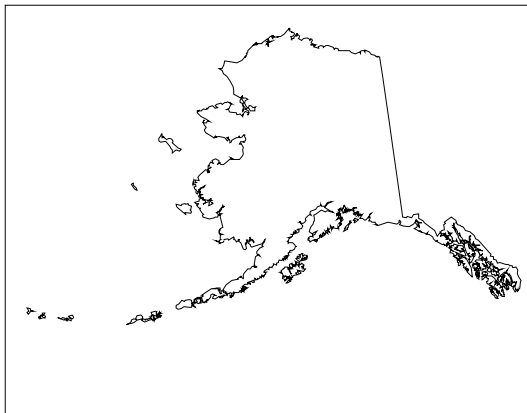

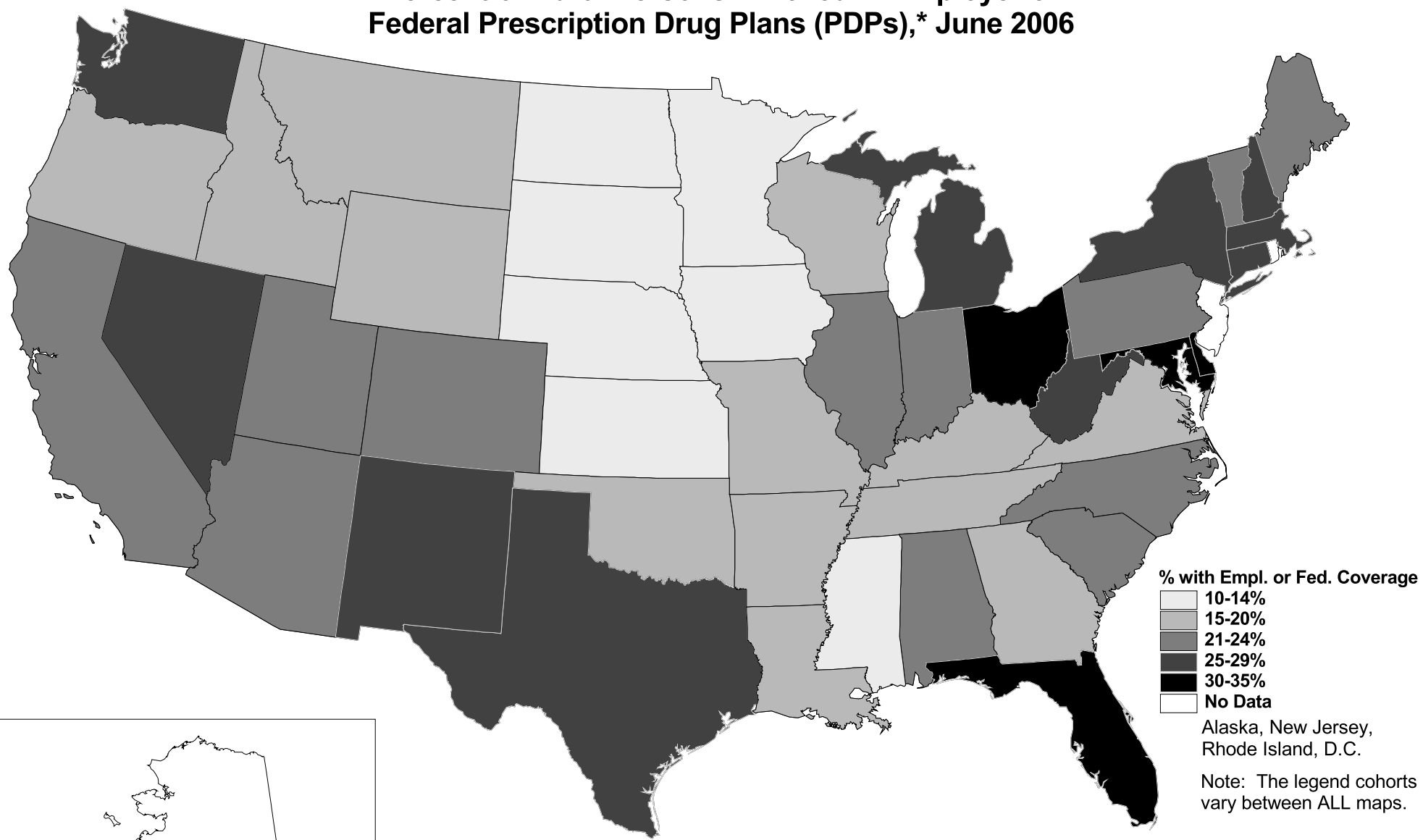

Percent of Rural Persons Enrolled in Employer or Federal Prescription Drug Plans (PDPs),* June 2006

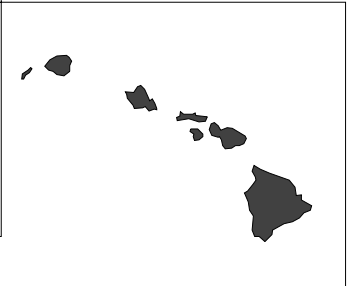
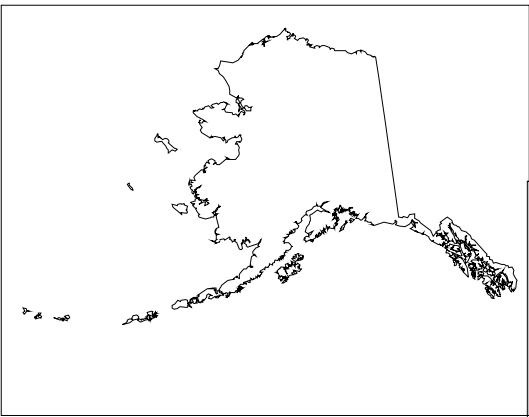

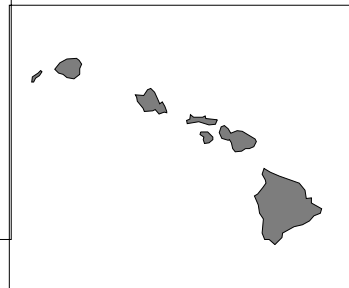
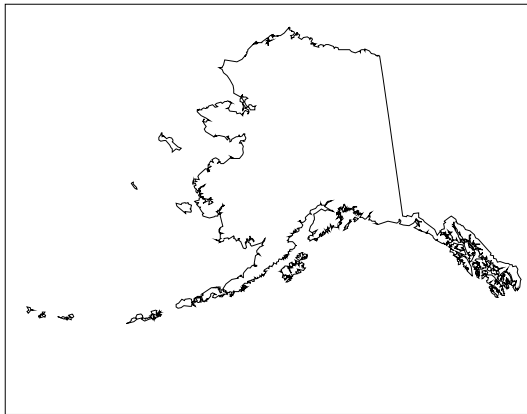
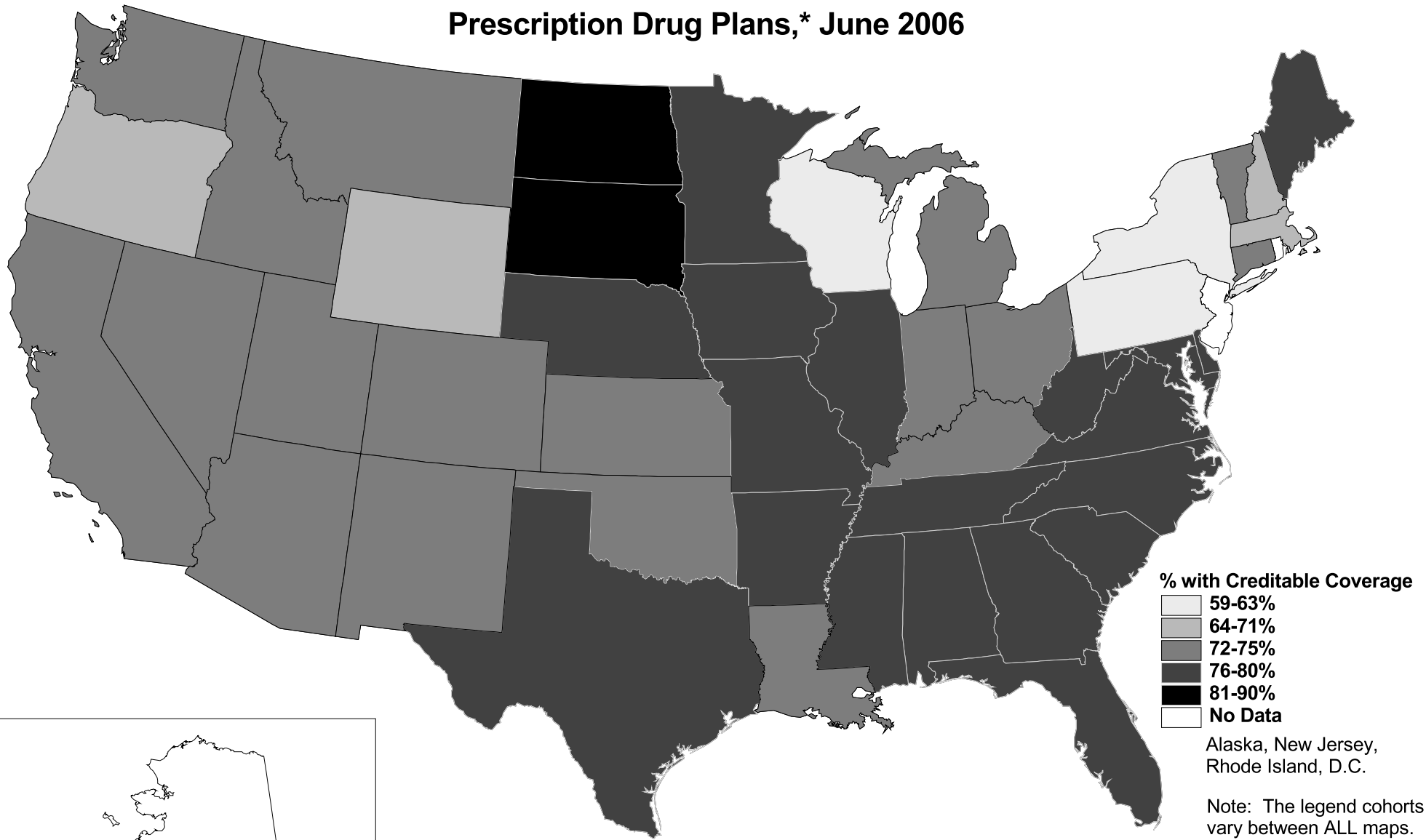
