This letter is provided on behalf of a prospective applicant interested in applying to the University of Nebraska Medical Center Interservice Physician Assistant Program (IPAP) through the Army.

To assist in determining eligibility for Army IPAP, the required prerequisite courses are outlined below. Please note that the science courses must be completed within 8 years of starting the program, and Medical terminology must be completed within 5 years of starting the program.

- Anatomy & Physiology I and Anatomy & Physiology II – 6-8 semester credit hours
OR: Human Anatomy and Human Physiology – 6-8 semester credit hours
- General Chemistry I – 3-4 semester credit hours
- General Chemistry II – 3-4 semester credit hours
- College Algebra – 3 semester credit hours
- English Composition – 6 semester credit hours
- Humanities – 6 semester credit hours
- Psychology – 3 semester credit hours
- Medical Terminology

In addition to the prerequisite requirements listed above, the following courses are highly recommended:

- Biochemistry
- Biology
- Microbiology
- Organic Chemistry
- Sociology
