To assist in determining eligibility for Coast Guard IPAP, the required prerequisite courses are outlined below. Please note that the science courses and medical terminology must be completed within 8 years of the application deadline.

- Anatomy & Physiology I and Anatomy & Physiology II – 6-8 semester credit hours
OR: Human Anatomy and Human Physiology – 6-8 semester credit hours
- General Chemistry I – 3-4 semester credit hours
- General Chemistry II – 3-4 semester credit hours
- College Algebra – 3 semester credit hours
- English Composition – 6 semester credit hours
- Humanities – 6 semester credit hours
- Psychology – 3 semester credit hours
- Medical Terminology

In addition to the prerequisite requirements listed above, the following courses are highly recommended:

- Biochemistry
- Microbiology
- Organic Chemistry
- Abnormal Psychology
