



COLLEGE OF ALLIED HEALTH PROFESSIONS **Innovative Scholarship Award**

This award recognizes a CAHP faculty or staff member whose innovative scholarship advances the mission of the College and has a lasting impact on this community. Innovative scholarship may include ingenuity and creativity in the development of a novel educational, clinical, or scholarly product or process.

ELIGIBLE CANDIDATES

- **Rank:** All faculty and staff in the College of Allied Health Professions (CAHP) at the University of Nebraska Medical Center.
- **Experience:** CAHP faculty or staff member for 2 years or more (from award submission deadline).
- Past recipients of this award are re-eligible 5 years following the receipt of the award.

AWARD CRITERIA (Candidates are expected to meet most of the criteria)

- Innovation
 - Developed or revised a product/process that improved clinical, educational or scholarly work.
- Assessment
 - Demonstrated product/process assessment and summarized results.
- Dissemination
 - Distributed product/process both internally and externally to CAHP/UNMC.
- Impact
 - Advanced the health professions through the development of the product/process.

NOMINATION MATERIALS

Nominators for the innovative Scholarship Award are responsible for submitting all nomination materials.

1. Nomination form

Submitted nomination form (self-nominations are permitted). All CAHP faculty, staff, and students may nominate a candidate for this award.

2. Nominator's personal letter of support

Nominator statement must emphasize evidence of award criteria. (No more than two pages.)

3. Letters of support (2)

Two letters of support highlighting the nominee's creative and/or innovative scholarly contributions to the health professions. (No more than two pages each.)
