This award recognizes those who have offered significant and exemplary contributions to the advancement of the Allied Health Professions.

ELIGIBLE CANDIDATES

- Individual or group of individuals whose contributions to the allied health professions are significant, lasting, and meaningful. An affiliation with the University is not required.
- Past recipients of this award are not re-eligible for the award.

AWARD CRITERIA (Candidates are expected to meet most of the criteria)

- Instrumental in promoting the mission, values, and growth of the College of Allied Health Professions.
- Evidence of a distinguished record of service in the allied health professions in one or more of the following areas of:
 - administration
 - community service
 - program development
 - service to members

NOMINATION MATERIALS

Nominators for are responsible for submitting all nomination materials.

1. Nomination Form

Submitted nomination form (self-nominations are not permitted). All CAHP faculty and students may nominate a candidate for this award.

2. Nominator's personal letter of support

Nominator statement must emphasize evidence of award criteria.

3. Letters of Support

Two letters of support (e.g. colleagues, directors, peers, students) that speak to the nominee's qualifications for this award (recommended one page in length).
