
56th Midwest Student Biomedical Research Forum

The Midwest Student Biomedical Research Forum (MSBRF) offers an exceptional platform for emerging researchers across health sciences, graduate programs, internships, and residency programs throughout the Midwest to showcase their work in biomedical sciences.

Participants can present their research in either an oral or poster format. The Forum is a valuable opportunity for students to have their original research reviewed, evaluated, and recognized by peers and established scientists. Every abstract submitted undergoes a peer review process similar to that used in major scientific journals. Financial awards are granted in several categories for outstanding presentations.

Since its inception, the MSBRF has evolved into a significant gathering for young scientists. The most recent forum, held in March 2024, attracted over 180 students from Midwestern medical schools, marking another successful event.

Co-sponsored by the University of Nebraska Medical Center and Creighton University since 1987, MSBRF continues to foster scientific collaboration and innovation among young researchers.
