












Multiple bystanders present. The blanket has debris as does the open wound.




He is agitated and crying intermittently. C/O burning of his eyes and says he can't feel his lips. Says he thought the car might have been on fire when they hit the deer.






Patient is coughing up blood and is unable to speak

















There are several bystanders who want to help, or want you to do something. They're loud. And bossy. And kinda pale themselves.






His biggest concern is the state of his children and his wife. He states he does not really feel any pain anymore as long as he does not move his eyes.





Patient is cooperative but nervous and insists that you do NOT call his wife. His friends are all taking pictures and making TikToks....






Your patient is very upset and crying. He is apprehensive about your arrival and is refusing to leave his mom's lap. He keeps attempting to grab the fork.

...is safe?


