ADVANCED CARDIOVASCULAR LIFE SUPPORT



Advanced Cardiovascular Life Support (ACLS) is a nationally recognized program designed by the American Heart Association (AHA) for health care providers involved in the resuscitation of a patient, whether in or out of the hospital. Through this course, providers will enhance their skills in the management and treatment of an adult victim of a cardiac arrest or other cardiopulmonary emergencies. The material will be covered in small group lectures, demonstrations, evaluation of case-based scenarios, and practice.

The **ACLS Provider** is a **two-day course** designed for the health care provider who either has never attended an ACLS Provider course, would like to enhance knowledge of ACLS content and skills, or has an expired ACLS card. (PREREQUISITE: **Current** AHA BLS Provider card / CREDIT: 14 *AMA PRA Category 1 Credits™*)

The **ACLS Renewal** is a **one-day course** designed for the health care provider who has previously completed an ACLS Provider course and has a solid understanding of the ACLS Provider course content. (PREREQUISITE: **Current** AHA BLS Provider card **AND** **Current** ACLS Provider card / CREDIT: 7 *AMA PRA Category 1 Credits™*)
