<u>PURPOSE</u>: The purpose of this standard operating procedure (SOP) is to ensure clean removal of equipment from presumed Covid-19 positive patient room.

SCOPE: This SOP applies to all research conducted at University of Nebraska Medical Center (UNMC) and Nebraska Medicine (NM).

PERSONNEL RESPONSIBLE: All Clinical Research Center staff.

REQUIRED ITEMS:

- ✓ 2 Bags large enough to accommodate equipment
- ✓ 1 Roll of medical tape if the bags are not zip locked
- ✓ Liquid sanitizer
- ✓ Disinfectant wipes

PROCEDURES:

- 1. Ensure patient's room has hand sanitizer and disinfectant wipes. If not, gather them.
- 2. Tape 1st bag to outside entry of patient's room for easy access.
- 3. Don PPE, per protocol.
- 4. Take 2nd bag, tape, and sanitizer and wipes as needed and enter room.
- 5. Gather equipment, wipe it down with a disinfectant wipe and place into the box it came in and then into a bag.
- 6. Tape bag closed or zip shut if a zip lock bag.
- 7. Cleanse the outside of bag with a disinfectant wipe and gloved hands with sanitizer until all surface areas are treated.
- 8. Wipe the door handle and any other surfaces touched prior to opening the door
- 9. Open room door and place 1st bag of equipment into 2nd bag and leave outside of room.
- 10. Doff PPE, per protocol.
- 11. Seal and take 2nd bag with equipment to designated personnel.
