



Dear Doctor:

_____ has applied for membership at the UNMC Center for Healthy Living in order to exercise. If they request, the participant will receive guidance in structuring their activity program. Staff will work individually with each participant to ensure that they are familiar with a health-oriented approach to physical activity. However, the center does not provide medically supervised exercise sessions. Participants will be expected to exercise independently and accept responsibility for monitoring their own reaction to physical activity.

The simple fitness testing available at the center is **not** intended to be diagnostic in nature and **does not** have the ability to assess the health of the cardiovascular system.

Our staff is trained in CPR and the facility is equipped with an automated external defibrillator (AED) to respond to emergency medical situations.
