




# Shipping UN 1845, Dry Ice, 9

Note: Dry Ice is a Dangerous Good Regulated by the Department of Transportation (DOT) & International Air Transport Association (IATA)

# Shipping UN 1845, Dry Ice, 9

Note: Dry Ice is a Dangerous Good Regulated by the Department of Transportation (DOT) & International Air Transport Association (IATA)

## Outer Packaging Requirements:

- Class 9 label, Dry ice, and UN number properly affixed
- Shipper's name and address must be listed
- Consignee name and address must be listed
- Net weight of dry ice shown, in Kilograms
- Outer package must be closed to allow the release of pressure caused by its sublimation

## Inner Packaging Requirements:

- Basic triple packaging is required to ship dry ice
- Never put dry ice in the primary container!
- The dry ice must surround the secondary container
- Dry ice must be shipped in a Styrofoam container placed into a sturdy outer container
- The Styrofoam container must allow the release of pressure caused by its sublimation






## Shipping Exempt Human (or Animal) Specimen


Note: Exempt Human or Animal Specimens shipped by themselves are not considered Dangerous Goods but must be shipped by a UNMC certified shipper.

Section	Description	
A	Ship "From" and "To"	The full name and address of the shipper ("from") and consignee ("to") must be clearly printed on the airbill and the info <u>must</u> be the same on the package.
B	Certified Shipper	The name of the UNMC <u>certified</u> shipper must be documented on the airbill.
C	Proper shipping name	The proper shipping name "Exempt Human (or Animal) Specimen" must be documented on the airbill.
D	Does this shipment contain dangerous goods?	Exempt Human (or Animal) Specimens shipped by themselves are not considered Dangerous Goods.




