Dear Mr. Theis:

This refers to the reactive inspection conducted by Michael Gries, Bryan Miller, and Bryce Davidson of this office on August 22, 2025, of activities authorized by your Nebraska Radioactive Material License No. 01-88-01. Our findings were discussed with Robert Kamstra, Dr. Ryan Downey, and you at the conclusion of this inspection.

This inspection was an examination of the activities and records that pertained to a reportable medical event that occurred at your facility on August 12, 2025.

Based on the results of this inspection, certain of your activities were not conducted in full compliance with Title 180, as set forth in the Notice of Noncompliance enclosed herewith.

This is to advise you that you are required to post a notice of violation of radiological working conditions (see enclosure). Any noncompliance item with respect to the Regulations or the conditions of the license is considered a violation of working conditions per 180 NAC 10-002.01(D).

- (1) Corrective actions which have been taken by you and the results achieved.
- (2) Corrective actions which will be taken to avoid further items of noncompliance.

## NOTICE OF NONCOMPLIANCE The Nebraska Medical Center Radioactive Material License No. 01-88-01

Based on the results of the Nebraska Department of Health & Human Services, Division of Public Health inspection conducted on August 22, 2025, certain of your activities are in noncompliance with Title 180 (Control of Radiation) and the conditions of your Radioactive Material License No. 01-88-01 as indicated below:

1. 180 NAC 7-020.02 requires, among other things, that a licensee's procedures for administrations requiring written directives must account for the verification that the specific details of the administration are in accordance with the written directive.

Contrary to the above, on August 12, 2025, the licensee failed to verify that the specific details of an administration were according to the written directive. Specifically, the licensee failed to verify that the radioactive drug and the dosage of the radioactive drug were in accordance with the written directive. The written directive stated that the patient was to be injected with a therapeutic dose of Pluvicto (Lu-177), but was instead injected with a therapeutic dose of Xofigo (Ra-223).

This is a Severity Level III violation.
