

Honeywell DC300 N95 Respirators

The voluntary use of *Honeywell DC300 N95 disposable respirators* is not part of the UNMC Respiratory Protection Program.

Do NOT wear these respirators:

- In clinical or research settings where specific respiratory protection is required.
- If you have certain types of facial hair that interrupt the intended seal of the respirator to your face.
- If you have difficulty breathing or other cardiopulmonary issues.
- If damaged, wet, or soiled.
- With other face coverings.
