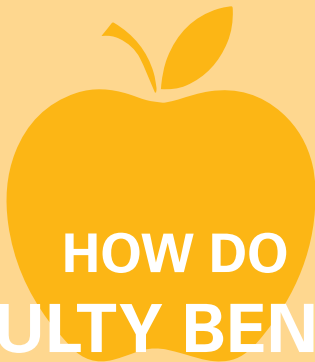

Boost your CV (and P&T opportunities) with scholarly work — gain access to UNMC experts for research analysis and help turning your innovation into publication

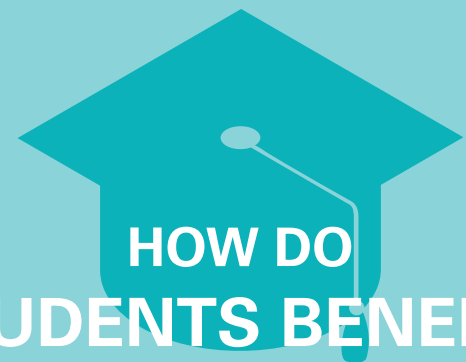

» Faculty lead the project

Application process and content expertise is handled by faculty members.

» 2 – 4 students per team

Collaboration among interprofessional teams is encouraged.

» \$1,000 awarded per team

Use it for project creation or student stipends.

» Topic selection your choice

Choose a topic students need supplemental information on or that they find difficult to retain.

» Type of interactivity up to you
