The student selected for this research experience will shadow one lab member first to learn physiological, biochemical, and molecular techniques. The student will then have the opportunity to use these techniques in some experiments designed in our basic and translational projects.

The student will also need to attend all lab research activities, such as lab meetings, discussing research papers, and seminars related to our research. Finally, the student should present about her/his studies in the lab (including program director).

- Completed application for the program
- Curriculum Vitae (CV) or Résumé
- One letter of reference

The program will begin June 1st, provided all onboarding activities are completed at that time and run for 10 weeks. Students will receive a \$3,000 stipend.
