

Overview

- Assistant and associate professors represent 2/3 of all participants
- 28% of participants live streamed from remote locations
- 48 faculty participated in UNMC’s on-boarding event, “The Essential Guide for New Faculty Success”

Building Longitudinal Faculty Communities

- 70 faculty and staff participated in monthly meetings of the Education, Technology and Collaboration learning community
- 35 faculty and staff participated in the Simulation Interest Group, a collaborative community for those interested in simulation
- 115 faculty and staff attended the annual Premier Education Banquet where key educators showcased innovative ideas in teaching and learning

Fostering Innovation

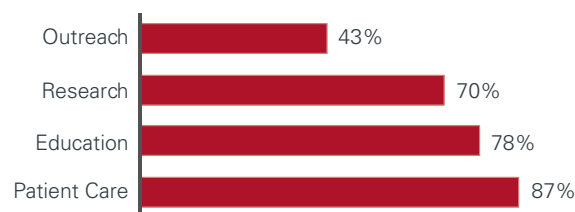
- Faculty Development organized a campus-wide task force to establish an interprofessional academy of educators
- All UNMC campuses have access to both synchronous and asynchronous faculty development learning
- 477 faculty registered for the online platform to attend faculty development events
- Faculty Development partnered with Academic Affairs and the E-Learning Steering Committee to distribute \$140,135 to faculty innovators who participated in the Interactive E-Learning Program

Future Directions

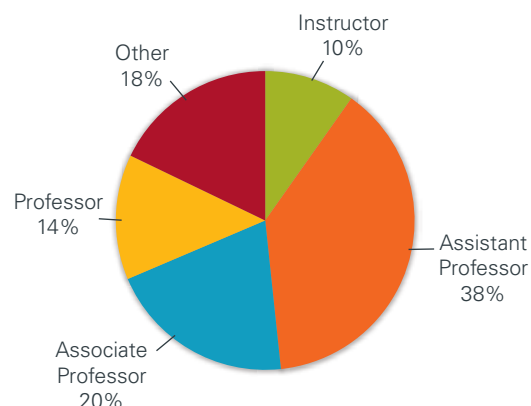
- Develop an ongoing leadership community to foster interprofessional collaboration and mentoring
