Free student registrations for Global Health Conference

UNMC students are invited to participate in the Global Health Conference Midwest, sponsored by Creighton University. "Many Communities, One Health" is the theme of the event, which will be held Feb. 3-4. The popular conference features keynote speakers, panels and breakout sessions covering a range of global health topics. New for 2023 is the addition of the Great Plains Native American Health Symposium (GPNAHS).

The Office of Global Engagement (OGE) will pay the registration fee for up to 20 UNMC students to attend the conference.
