

Graduate Studies Teaching and Mentoring Badge Requirements

Students receiving a Teaching and Mentoring Badge will be required to complete the following:

1. View at least three of the webinars from the Teaching and Mentoring Badge Webinar Library and submit a badge form (4+ hours) to reflect on what you learned and document this activity.
 - If you are focusing on classroom-based teaching, it is recommended that you select at least two from the teaching and learning section.
 - If you are focusing on laboratory-based teaching and/or mentoring, it is recommended that you select at least two from the mentoring section.
2. Complete the Teaching Self-Evaluation Form and/or Mentoring Competency Assessment. Submit a badge form (1 hour) to reflect on your teaching and/or mentoring skills. Submit the required teaching and mentoring reflection form to reflect on what you learned in each experience and document this experience. *Upload documentation of the event, your role, and/or other relevant information about the event.*

and at least two of the following teaching and mentoring experiences, for a total of 20 hours of activity.

3. Participate as a mentor for a calendar year in an official peer mentoring program (e.g. PAC consultant or IGPBS or CON mentoring program).
4. Participate in an organized educational outreach activity or other formal teaching experience not required by your degree program.
5. Serve as a supplemental instructor as part of the Supplemental Instruction program organized by the Division of Student Success.
6. Serve as teacher/mentor for a High school Alliance Student, a summer undergraduate student, or rotating graduate student. For teaching/mentoring that falls into the research training category, a maximum of 1 hr. per week of teaching/mentoring can be claimed for a max of 10 hrs.
7. Serve as a UNMC Global Ambassador through the Office of Global Engagement.
8. Participate in teaching in the High School Alliance or other voluntary classroom-based teaching opportunity.
9. Engage in another teaching or mentoring activity that has been approved by the Assistant Dean of Graduate Student Success* (max 10 hrs.)
