

# Tissue Procurement

## Standards of Practice Agreement

This Tissue Procurement Standards of Practice Agreement (“Agreement”) is made on this \_\_\_\_\_ day of \_\_\_\_\_ (the “Effective Date”), by \_\_\_\_\_ (the “Company”), with a place of business at \_\_\_\_\_ and the Board of Regents of the University of Nebraska, a public body corporate for, the University of Nebraska Medical Center and its Interprofessional Experiential Center for Enduring Learning (“Customer”) with a place of business at 4111 Emile Street, Omaha Nebraska 68198-6160. Company and Customer are referred to herein as “Party” or collectively, as “Parties”.

WHEREAS, Customer desires to procure donated tissue for use in educational and research activities; and

WHEREAS, Company supplies donated tissue for use in educational and research activities.

NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration the mutual covenants contained herein and other good and valuable consideration, the receipt and sufficiency of which is hereby acknowledged, and intending to be legally bound, Company and Customer hereby agree as follows:

I. Company represents and warrants the following:

### **Tissue Procurement**

- Company has a standard application process the Customer completes prior to being approved to request tissue(s).
- Donor or representative for donor has no financial responsibility for and receives no compensation for donation to the Company.
- Company obtains proper consent for all donated tissue before donation process can be complete.

### **Tissue Handling/Care**

- Company has a process to conduct serology lab work on all tissue(s) prior to disposition to the Customer.
- Company has tracking requirements (Donor ID tags and corresponding paperwork) of the Customer to ensure tissue(s) are identifiable and tracked throughout the entire process.
- Company can verify specific anatomy and absence of hardware through various methods such as X-Rays, Ultrasounds and medical history.
- Company can provide CAT scans compatible with specific medical device equipment (robotics, stealth, etc.).

### **Tissue Disposition**

- Company can provide whole and/or segmented fresh tissue.
- Company processes ensure donor remains disposition is consistent with the donor or donor family/representative agreement.
- Company processes ensure secure delivery and provides adequate transportation to support fresh cadaveric tissue.

II. The Parties agree to comply with any applicable import and export control laws, rules, and regulations relating to the import and export of human tissue, materials, and products in

connection with any procurement and transfer of human tissue under this Agreement and any purchase order(s).

IN WITNESS WHEREOF, the Parties have caused this Agreement to be executed as of the Effective Date by their duly authorized representatives.
