

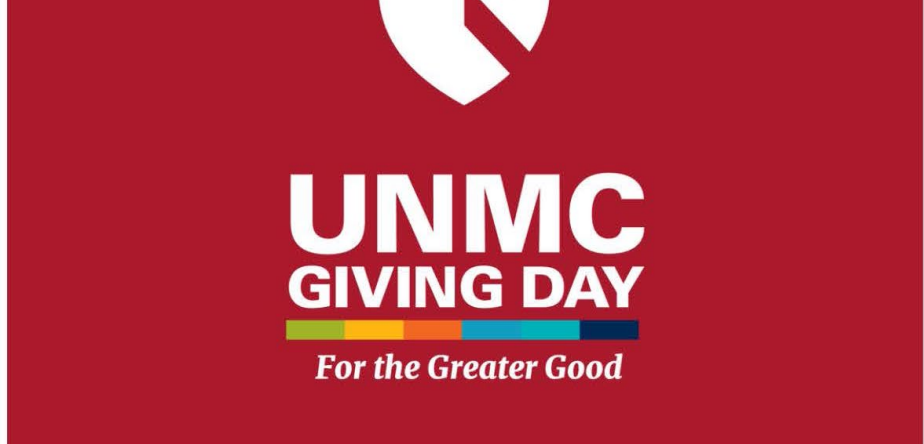

iWall Training Breakthrough



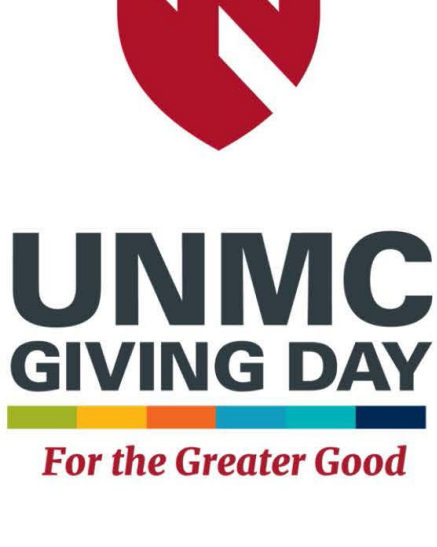
