



Associate Dean / Education & Research Services Librarian

The McGoogan Health Sciences Library at the University of Nebraska Medical Center seeks a collaborative, innovative, and values-driven candidate to apply for its Associate Dean position. This individual strengthens library core services and supports the development of library services and programming for UNMC's teaching, research, and clinical support areas. They also have responsibility for building partnerships with the six UNMC health sciences colleges, other UNMC campuses, and other universities within the University of Nebraska system.

As a member of the library's leadership team, the Associate Dean assists in implementing the library's strategic plan and leading an evolving portfolio of projects and priorities in a collaborative and dynamic environment. The Associate Dean joins a team that practices participatory decision-making and models [UNMC's iTEACH values](#). The Associate Dean participates in planning, shared governance, and library-wide faculty activities. They will supervise faculty and staff in library units including education, research, collections, and communications.

As a faculty member of the Education & Research Services team, they will have liaison, instruction, and research support roles. This position requires scholarship, professional development, and service that contributes to the effectiveness of the library, the university, and the profession. Liaison and Associate Dean duties are split approximately 50%.

The ideal candidate will have:

- Administrative and supervisory experience in an academic or health sciences library.
- Demonstrated leadership qualities, including a participatory leadership style that fosters respect and collegiality; strong managerial skills; ability to be creative, take appropriate risks, and make timely decisions.
- Experience providing instruction and research support in an academic health sciences library.
- Excellent public presentation, interpersonal, and communication skills.
- Demonstrated understanding of the principles of diversity, equity, and inclusion and how they relate to the mission of the McGoogan Health Sciences Library.

This is a full-time, 12-month position. This position is on-site in Omaha, with partial remote work flexibility. A Master's degree in library science from an ALA-accredited institution or an advanced degree in a relevant discipline is required. Faculty participate in campus service and



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receive support to pursue professional development. This is not a tenure-leading faculty position, but all faculty may elect to pursue tenure or promotion. Individuals from diverse populations are encouraged to apply.
