

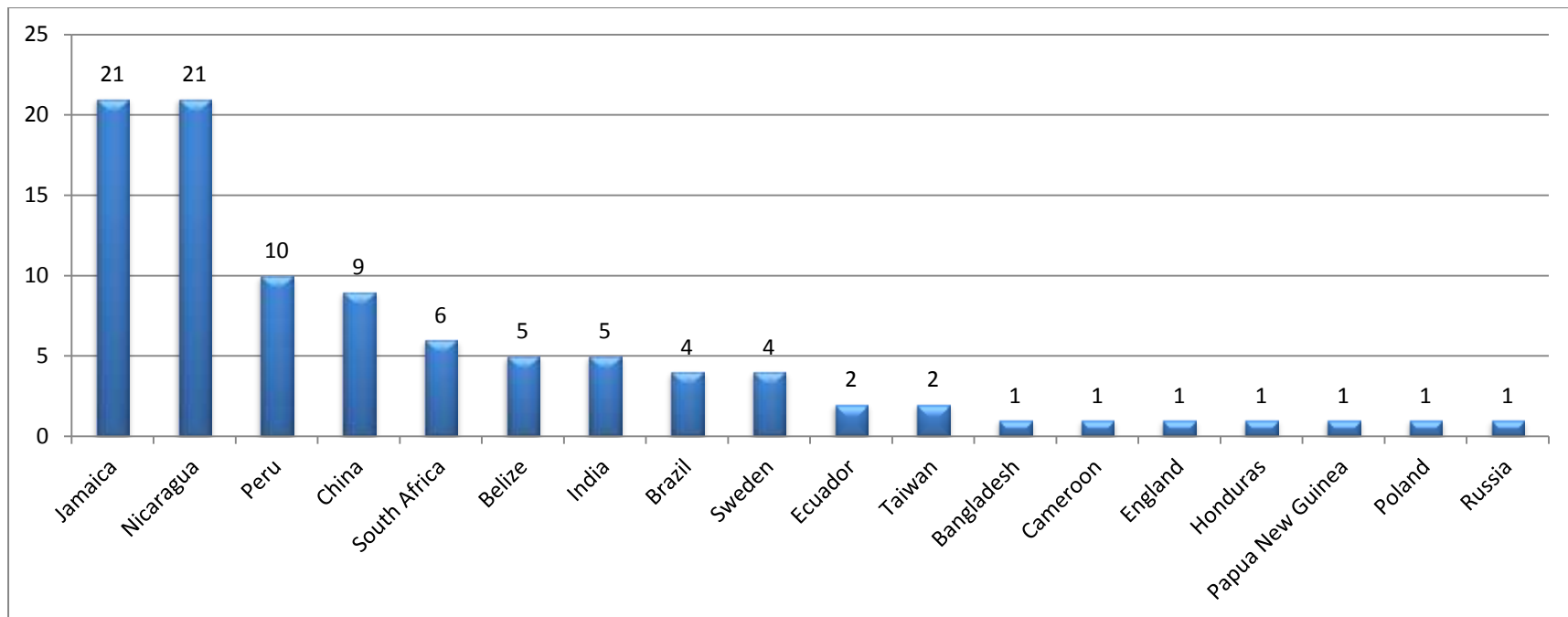


UNMC Students' *Global Health Experiences*

July 2012 – June 2013

From July 2012 through June 2013, **96 UNMC students** participated in one or more international medical/health experiences, ranging from one to four weeks long. Of this total, 38 students were from the College of Medicine, 14 from the School of Allied Health Professions, 23 from the College of Nursing, 15 from the College of Pharmacy, four from the College of Public Health, and two from the College of Graduate Studies.

- 2 graduate students completed a global health experiences
- 4 public health students completed global health experiences
- 21 students participated in a medical service trip to Jamaica (COM and COP)
- 16 students participated in a medical service trip to Nicaragua (COM and CON)
- 17 different countries visited
