Munroe Home Watercolor Dedicated

A watercolor of the first Hattie B. Munroe Home for Convalescing Children, located at 2824 N. 66th Ave., was dedicated Thursday at the present Hattie B. Munroe Pavilion, 4420 Dewey Ave. Commissioned by the board, the painting by W. Donald Boe is a memorial to the late Mrs. Dean McWhorter, purchased with donations from her family and friends. Mrs. W. H. Taylor Jr., was chairman of the project.

Dr. Neal Vanselow, chancellor of the University of Nebraska College of Medicine, and

past and present board members, including Mrs. McWhorter's son, Steve McWhorter, attended the 4 p.m. ceremony.

The original home opened for 12 patients in September 1922 in the house donated in memory of Mrs. John B. Munroe. Two wings were added the following year.

The present site was leased to the board in December 1956, and in 1968 the university agreed to share responsibility for programs and funds. Forty-four children are served at the present facility.
