Each year, the Munroe-Meyer Institute provides more than 70,000 services to clients across the lifespan; and

The Munroe-Meyer Institute is the home to Nebraska's University Center for Excellence in Developmental Disabilities, one of only 67 federally designated centers in the country, and a site for the Leadership Education in Neurodevelopmental and related Disabilities Training Program, the nationwide, interdisciplinary training program for health professionals who work with children with neurodevelopmental disabilities; and

On August 26, 2019, the Institute held a ceremonial groundbreaking at the site of its new home at 6902 Pine St.; and

WHEREAS.

The new building will allow MMI to build on existing strengths to amplify the impact on its patient population and their families with new and expanded programs and partnerships and an integrated care model; and

WHEREAS,

The City of Omaha recognizes MMI's legacy and impact on the lives of the clients and families it serves.
