Criteria for Presentations to Meet ASHA and/or ALTA CEU Requirements

For a Conference Session to be offered for ASHA and/or ALTA CEU's, please see attached submission guidelines. No personal interest session or product sales will qualify.

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Registration

All presenters (oral sessions or posters) are required to register for the Conference and are to arrange own travel and hotel accommodations.

Continuing Education Units (CEUs)

As a presenter of a session offered for ASHA and/or ALTA CEUs, you may claim credit for your own session, earning the same amount of credit as participants.

ASHA: This program is offered for ASHA CEUs at the intermediate level, professional area.

ALTA: Academic Language Therapy Association is an organization of certified academic language therapists who have received training to work specifically with students identified with dyslexia. Application in process for ALTA CEUs.

Oral Presentations

Conference presentations are intended to provide in-depth, continuing education for speech language pathologists, audiologists and dyslexia specialists. Emphasis is on clinical applications and research advances, backed by appropriate levels of evidence. Presentations can be anywhere from 60 – 120 minutes in length. Please indicate your preference for length of session. Based on submissions, requested length may be adjusted.

Poster Presentations

Poster presentations should visually guide viewers through the basics of the study displayed on the poster board while the presenter focuses on the explanation and clarification of the key elements of the work and answers viewers' questions. The poster presentation format is less formal and more interactive than an oral seminar. Poster session will take place in the evening on Wednesday, September 25 and presenters must be present with their poster.

Conflict of Interest Disclosures and Call for Papers Agreement

For consideration, anyone presenting or listed as an author for presentation, is required to complete a disclosure indicating any financial or non-financial relationship to the content of the session. Presenters should begin their session with a slide and verbal statement indicating their adherence to the agreement and disclosing any potential conflicts. Poster presentations should include a similar written statement on the poster.

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Handouts

This will be a paperless conference and no handouts will be available onsite. All handouts will be available on the conference website and should be downloaded prior to the start of each session. Final versions of electronic handouts must be submitted to upload onto the conference website no later than September 12, 2024.
