University of Nebraska Medical Center (UNMC) offers a two-year post-doctoral fellowship in Clinical Neuropsychology under the Department of Neurological Sciences, Neuropsychology division. Our program is located on the main Nebraska Medicine hospital campus in midtown Omaha, Nebraska.

Our division currently includes 5 neuropsychologists, 6 psychometrists, 2 administrative assistants, and 1 neuropsychology fellow. In September of each year, we welcome one new fellow into our program, with anticipation of 2 fellows in 2026.

Training Objectives

Training is based on Houston Conference Guidelines for specialty training in clinical neuropsychology. Our program emphasizes preparing trainees for state psychology licensure and future board certification in clinical neuropsychology. Preparation for board certification is integrated through clinical training and didactics. At graduation, our fellows are proficient in conducting neuropsychological assessments with a wide variety of neurological, medical, and psychiatric patient populations and typically move on to careers in academic medical centers, VA medical centers, or rehabilitation hospitals.

What We Offer

Clinical Training:

- Outpatient clinical rotations include:
 - 1) Pre-neuros urgical evaluations (epilepsy, DBS)
 - 2) Memory and movement disorders
 - 3) General neurology/specialized neurosurgery evaluations (multiple sclerosis, stroke, brain injury, neuro-oncology, Wada, language mapping)
 - 4) General medical/psychiatric disorders
- Cognitive rehabilitation in group settings
- Minimum of 2 hours of face-to-face supervision per week
- Five supervising faculty (3 board certified)
- Possible opportunity for vertical supervision, depending on the training year

Research:

- Opportunity to participate In ongoing research projects within the department of Neurological Sciences and University of Nebraska Medical Center.
- Fellows will co-author at least one poster or paper during their two-year tenure.

Didactics:

- Weekly: Neurops ychology Fellows hip Seminar, Neurology Grand Rounds
- Monthly: Neuropsychology Journal Club, Boards Prep, Professional Development, Neuropsychology Case Conference
- Neuroanatomy course offered within the department
- Additional optional educational opportunities: Brain cuttings, neurology residency didactics, shadowing pediatric neuropsychologists, neurologists, geriatricians, oncologists, and surgeries
