



Local:

City Council: Another role of a city council member is being an advocate for the people. You can participate in issues that interest you at a city council meeting.

They hold:

- Elections
- Collect taxes
- Makes city upgrades
- Approves contracts
- Puts into effect traffic regulations

The Council adopts or changes the budget proposed by the mayor and provides the necessary funds and supplies for departments.

County board:

The powers of the County as a political body are carried out by the County Board as follows:

- Direct all County money and business
- Looks at all accounts, receipts, and costs
- Yearly fees and collects taxes
- Has the ability to sell, move, exchange, or rent any property owned by the County.

School Board:

The school board believes that it is the responsibility of the school district to provide a positive learning environment for the children of the community. People select the Board to advocate for them and to provide:

- Local educational plans
- Policies
- Goals
- Objectives

The Board also shares responsibility with:

- Students
- Parents
- Administrators
- Teachers
- Other school employees
- Community members

The school boards have many responsibilities. They work to serve their best interests in performance and safety for their students at the local level.
