This award-winning film explores the stories of women battling opioid use disorder and the neglect of women’s health care needs in the U.S.

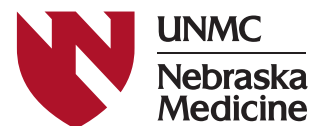
A panel discussion will follow the screening.
