

Reminder: SPA's 3-day rule is being enforced! In order for the College of Nursing to comply, documents need to be to us 5 business days in advance of the agency's deadline. Your abstract, research plan & bibliography can be in draft form –final versions due 1 day prior to the deadline. Applications that miss the 3-day rule will be reviewed and processed last.

Effective January 25, 2018, NIH issued a new Human Subjects and Clinical Trials Information Form. This form consolidates all the Human Subjects and Clinical Trial related information in one place. It is hoped that this new form better captures clinical trial information needed for peer review and presents key information to reviewers and agency staff in a consistent format.

Now that we had a little experience with this form, here is some important information to keep in mind if you will be submitting a future application involving a clinical trial.

- All projects with human subjects must complete a “study record.”
- Some projects have 1 study record and some have multiple study records, typically dependent upon the aims of the project.
- The study record is comprised of 4 major sections. All human subject research must complete Sections 1, 2 and part of 3. Clinical Trials must complete all 4 sections of the form.
- Several areas require text (with character limits) and have drop down menu selections.
- Section 4 requires a statistical design and power attachment as well as a dissemination plan.

NNRC staff will work with you to complete this form, but there are many parts which require specific input from investigators.

Mock Reviews held 3-4 weeks prior to submission are highly recommended for all grant applications!
