Tips on Subcontracts for Your Research Study

Subcontracts can take time – start ASAP – allow up to 12 weeks!

✓ **What is the difference between a Subcontract vs. Vendor vs. Consultant?**

Subcontract: Performs a significant portion of the scope of work/objectives of the program (Have effort on project). Collaborates in the project design/proposal development.

Vendor: Does not participate/ collaborate in project design/ proposal development. Performs services such as lab testing.

Consultant: Experts outside the University hired to perform a service on the project for a short period of time.

✓ **Subcontract Budget (Most Important Part of Sub)**

Step 1: Determine your overall budget

Step 2: Most importantly communicate with your subsite PI's.

Step 3: We receive back the R&R budget or excel sheet and work this into the overall budget of the grant.

New Internal Competitions Submission Process

UNMC has deployed a new web-based process for submitting proposals to internal competitions. NuRamp, an NU System-wide application, is being used for all intercampus funding competitions, reviews of core facilities, system-wide faculty awards, and importantly, UNMC Office of the Vice Chancellor for Research sponsored funding competitions. Recent competitions using NuRamp for the submission process included the NU Collaboration Initiative. The application is also available to colleges, departments, and centers who would like to manage competitions, whether for pilot funding programs or faculty/student abstract competitions.
