Dr. Schmidt provides cancer survivorship care to all cancer survivors as it relates to cancer surveillance, general health maintenance, and screening and treatment for side effects of cancer therapy. Dr. Schmidt collaborates with oncologists, surgeons, and supportive care providers to facilitate comprehensive care for patients with cancer and provides educational support on cancer issues for all patients and families, health team members, and the community.

Dr. Schmidt completed her Bachelor of Science in Nursing from Creighton University, followed by her Master of Science in Nursing with a specialization in Family Nurse Practitioner from Clarkson College. She then attained her Doctorate of Nursing Practice from the University of Nebraska Medical Center College of Nursing.
