Nebraska Medicine Addiction Services is a specialty continuum of care providing integrated treatment for co-occurring substance use and psychiatric disorders. We offer long-term outpatient services individualized to meet a patient's unique needs. Intensive outpatient treatment is also offered.

SERVICES OFFERED

- Medication for addiction (MAT) for alcohol, opioid and nicotine use disorders
- Group therapy
- Individual psychotherapy
- Medication treatment for psychiatric disorders

Our team is led by Alena Balasanova, MD, and Kenneth Zoucha, MD. Dr. Balasanova is board certified in psychiatry and addictive medicine. She and her team provide treatment for adults with co-occurring substance use and psychiatric disorders.

Dr. Zoucha is board certified in addictive medicine and pediatrics and cares for adolescent and adult patients with substance use disorders and co-occurring psychiatric disorders.

They are part of a multidisciplinary team that will work together to recommend and provide treatment to best fit the patient's needs.

WHO CAN BE REFERRED

- Patients of all ages with substance use disorder (SUD) and/or co-occurring psychiatric symptoms
- Chemical dependency (CD) evaluation is not necessary for referral
- Priority for patients seeking help for opioid and alcohol use disorders who may benefit from medications for addiction treatment

HOW TO REFER A PATIENT

- Discuss treatment goals with your patient to identify if Addiction Services would be an appropriate fit
- Nebraska Medicine providers can place an electronic order for "Ambulatory Referral to Addiction Services" in OneChart
- External providers can instruct patient to self refer by calling 402.552.6007. Providers can also place a call for referral
- Referred patients can receive a phone screening with one of our therapists
- Adolescent patients will be directly referred to Dr. Zoucha's clinic
