Jayme Dowdall, MD is a board-certified surgeon and Associate Professor in Otolaryngology – Head and Neck Surgery at the University of Nebraska Medical Center/Nebraska Medicine.

Dr. Dowdall received her medical degree from Boston University School of Medicine. Dr. Dowdall completed her residency at Wayne State University in Detroit, Michigan. During residency, she received the Holt Leadership Award from the American Academy of Otolaryngology - Head and Neck Surgery. She completed her clinical fellowship in Laryngology in 2012 at the Massachusetts Eye and Ear Infirmary. While practicing in Boston at MEEI and Brigham and Women's Hospital, she was also a research fellow at the Center for Regenerative Medicine with Dr. Jayaraj Rajagopal at Massachusetts General Hospital until 2015.



Dr. Dowdall specializes in a multi-disciplinary approach for laryngeal contributions to breathing disorders, gender affirming voice care and sex differences in upper airway conditions. She has expertise in advanced diagnostics, office-based laser surgery and a holistic approach for complex rehabilitation.

She has received awards for clinical collaboration, education, leadership and research innovation. Dr. Dowdall is known for her patient-centered approach and prefers to collaborate to create an integrated and holistic treatment plan for patients.
