



Research Excellence Award

Overview

This award recognizes one or two faculty members who demonstrate exceptional achievements in the research mission area. The recipient consistently exemplifies high standards of excellence in basic, translational, clinical, or population-level research. This could be reflected through one of more of the following dimensions: large grant awards, publications that change clinical practice or result in a scientific paradigm shift, inventions with broad implications, or advances in public health or biopreparedness.

Nomination Eligibility

- Full-time faculty appointment in any rank in the Department of Pathology, Microbiology, and Immunology.
- Previous awardees are not eligible for a period of 5 years.

Nomination Process

- Nominations may be submitted by self, peers, or members of the Faculty Recognition Awards Advisory Committee.
- Nominators will provide a brief synopsis summarizing the achievements of the nominee in the criteria below.

Award Criteria

Candidates eligible for this award shall satisfy one or more of the following criteria:

1. Highly impactful publication led by the candidate in a top tier journal with a deep impact in their field of study.
2. Large grant award led by the candidate.
3. Recorded invention led by the candidate with a broad impact.

Selection and Recognition

- One recipient will be selected annually.
- Awardees are selected via vote of all faculty, house officers, IPID graduate students, and postdoctoral fellows.
- Awardees will be recognized at the annual department holiday dinner.
