

Learning Across Borders: A Global Health Travel Experience

Summer 2026 | 3 credit hours

This course will provide an overview of global health issues and allow students to experience being a student who crosses borders to study public health in action abroad. Students will gain insights into the challenges and strategies involved in promoting and improving global health, with the Rwanda serving as a specific case study. Students will engage with real-world examples and experiences in Rwanda throughout the course through virtual and in-person interactions and field visits. This course includes international travel with additional fees associated beyond the course tuition.

Course: May 18 – Aug 15, 2026

Course Format: Online with 10+ Days of Travel to Rwanda (travel dates mid-late June TBD)

Course Deposit: \$500 due by Feb 13, 2026, nonrefundable, will go towards Program Travel Fees

Course Registration: Mar 15, 2026

Course Program Travel Fees: estimated \$5,000* (includes roundtrip airfare, accommodations, all meals, all in-country transportation)

Course Tuition: standard online tuition per credit hour
