#### Academic Honors

To recognize outstanding academic achievement of graduating students in College of Public Health professional degree-seeking programs, honors are awarded to those who have shown special proficiency and have excelled in their studies.

Graduation with honors is conferred in the following way:

The degree with **highest distinction** is awarded to students with a UNMC cumulative grade point average of 4.0.

The degree with **high distinction** is awarded to students with a UNMC cumulative grade point average of 3.85 or above.

The degree with **distinction** is awarded to students with a UNMC cumulative grade point average of 3.75 or above.

Final semester grades are not included and total hours at the College must exceed 30.

#### Delta Omega Honor Society

Gamma Omicron Chapter of the Delta Omega Honor Society in public health members are inducted to the chapter through a highly selective process that assesses their outstanding performance and devotion to the field.
