

# CPH 559 Special Topics: Learning Across Borders: A Global Health Travel Experience

Summer 2024 | 3 credit hours

This course will provide an overview of global health issues and allow students to experience being a student who crosses borders to study public health in action abroad. Students will gain insights into the challenges and strategies involved in promoting and improving global health, with the Rwanda serving as a specific case study. Students will engage with real-world examples and experiences in Rwanda throughout the course through virtual and in-person interactions and field visits. This course includes international travel with additional fees associated beyond the course tuition.

**Course:** May 13 – Aug 9, 2024

**Course Format:** Online with 10+ Days of Travel to Rwanda

**Course Deposit:** \$500 due by Feb 15, 2024, nonrefundable, will go towards Program Travel Fees

**Course Registration:** Mar 15, 2024

**Course Program Travel Fees:** estimated \$4,400\* (includes roundtrip airfare, accommodations, all meals, all in-country transportation)

**Course Tuition:** standard COPH online tuition per credit hour

**Course Availability:** open to all UNMC students, but space is very limited, deposit required to secure your place and register for the course
