RECURSOS EN ESPANOL – COVID-19



COVID-19 Y LA SALUD EN LAS ENGORDAS



No hay evidencia de que el ganado pueda transmitir COVID-19 a las personas o vice versa.

No hay restricciones en comercio de ganado pero si puede posponer las subastas de ganado, hágalo. De lo contrario tome medidas de distanciamiento apropiadas.

- El trabajo en las engordas es considerado esencial.
- Cuando se sienta enfermo, notifíquelo a su supervisor, quédese en casa y evite el contacto cercano con otras personas.
- Si no está enfermo con COVID-19, puede interactuar con los animales. Sin embargo, debe practicar una buena higiene durante esas interacciones:



Lávese las manos de 20 a 30 segundos

Use agua y jabón o un desinfectante para manos a base de alcohol con al menos 60% de alcohol.

Antes y después de interactuar con los animales, incluyendo el manejo de alimentos, suministros y desechos



Evite tocar su cara, nariz, boca, y ojos

Use el ángulo interno del brazo o un pañuelo desechable para toser o estornudar.



Limpie y desinfecte equipos y herramientas

Incluyendo las ATVs/UTVs (con énfasis en manubrios), carros de alimentación, manijetas y herramientas de mano



Use equipo de protección personal apropiado

p. ej., overol lavable, botas, guantes de cuero o de látex y tapabocas o una máscara N95



Conserve una distancia de 2 metros con las personas

En el lugar de trabajo, túrnense para tomar descansos, así evitará reunirse con más trabajadores al mismo tiempo en un mismo lugar.


