

Respiratory Protection During the COVID-19 Pandemic

How to Conserve Respiratory Supplies During COVID-19



- Disposable respirators (such as N95s) can be reused by the same person in a limited fashion
- Reusable respirators (such as facepiece respirators) can be reused after proper cleaning and sanitizing
- Cloth face masks are not an acceptable replacement for respirators that protect you from workplace respiratory hazards
- Discontinue and throw away masks that are no longer suitable for protection
- When available, N95 masks can prevent the spread of COVID-19
- Make sure you're wearing the proper mask for the task you are doing
