- Abstract, written for lay audience (half page)
- Budget
- Budget Justification
- Proposal (up to 5 pages)

- Budget justification can follow in the same order

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Opioid Prevention and Treatment RFP – Budget

Funds cannot be used for

- Financial contributions to individuals
- Fund-raising events
- Lobbying
- Projects which do not serve the designated geographical area
- · Promotional and incentive items
- Food or beverages
- Memberships and Dues



Opioid Prevention and Treatment RFP – Proposal

Should address the following

- Explain the basis of your interest in addressing the prevention priorities of this project
- Describe past successes in implementing comprehensive prevention strategies
- Provide past experience in community collaborations for project completion
- Describe current and potential coalition and staff capacity to complete project
- Address your experience in working in Nebraska or any Nebraska County, City, Town or Village
- Illustrate your ability to develop and collect outcome measures and evaluate project impact
- Identify potential target populations you propose to impact with strategies
- Outline potential strategies for addressing the community impact priorities, including the potential implementation throughout the state of Nebraska

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Cancer and Smoking Disease Research RFP - Format

- Use the forms provided (face page and application)
 - Footer = "2024-25 506 Application"
- Number all pages
- Do not exceed the page limits
- Save compiled application as "LastName, FirstName of Principal Investigator – LB506 – 2025"
 - Example: Smith, Mary LB506 2025
- All pages must be 8½ x 11, portrait orientation
- Arial/Helvetica, 11 point
 - A smaller, legible font size can be used ONLY for figures, charts, tables and footnotes
- One-inch margins on all sides



- · Section 1. General Information
 - · Face Page
 - · Table of Contents
 - Abstract
 - Key Personnel
 - · Budget Worksheet
 - · Budget Justification
 - · Biographical Sketches
 - Other Support
 - Certification of Non-Acceptance of Tobacco Funds

- Change: No longer asks if technical or behavioral
- 2g. New or revised
 - If revised, prior application number
- 3-5. Human subjects, vertebrate animals, recombinant DNA
 - If applicable to project, enter "PENDING" as the Approval/Exemption Date

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Cancer and Smoking Disease Research RFP – Key Personnel

- Individuals who contribute in a substantial way to the scientific development or execution of the research project, whether or not salaries are requested
- Include consultants only when their level of involvement meets this description
- Individuals providing technical services are not considered key personnel
- Key personnel must include biosketch



- Check the math on the budget worksheet and budget justification
- The same amounts must be requested in both the worksheet and justification
- In the justification, explain and itemize the costs captured on the worksheet in sufficient detail



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Cancer and Smoking Disease Research RFP – Budget

Approval/exemption date needed for Vertebrate Animals. Resubmit the budget worksheet and budget justification to capture the following changes: on the worksheet, the Benefits total is \$7,837 (not \$7,838), Personnel total is \$34,406 as a result. On the justification: provide more detail on animal housing costs.

Approval/exemption date needed for Recombinant DNA.

Resubmit budget justification to correct math errors in the Other budget. Flow Cytometry Core analysis equals \$777 (not \$774) and sorting total doesn't add up as described.

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Cancer and Smoking Disease Research RFP – Budget

Personnel (salaries and benefits)

- List PI first, followed by other Key Personnel, and then Support personnel
- Salary for the PI and other full-time faculty cannot be charged to the grant
- Salary and fringe benefit information is needed only for individuals funded by the grant
- Type of Appointment: Full-time (2,080 hours annually) appointments are assumed. If an appointment is less than full-time (e.g., ½ or ¾ time), enter an asterisk (*) after the number of months and provide an explanation in the Budget Justification
- State applicable fringe benefit rates in the Budget Justification



Consultant Costs

- Whether or not costs are involved, indicate in the Budget Justification the names and organizational affiliations for any consultants who have agreed to serve in that capacity
- Consultant costs are not allowed for full-time faculty or researchers at the same institution as the Principal Investigator
- Describe in the Budget Justification the services to be performed, including the number of consultation days, the expected rate of compensation, travel, per diem and any other related costs



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Cancer and Smoking Disease Research RFP – Budget

Equipment

- Although equipment costs are generally unallowable, there may be exceptions for scientific equipment if sufficient detail is provided in the Budget Justification
- Each tangible equipment item must be identified and have a cost assigned
- The purchase of office equipment including, but not limited to, computers and printers – is not allowed



Supplies

- Laboratory and office supplies that are needed to conduct the project are allowed
- Detail expenditures in the Budget Justification
- If animals are involved in the research project, state the species and explain in the Budget Justification why this type of animal is necessary



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Cancer and Smoking Disease Research RFP – Budget

Travel

- Only travel expenses incurred for collecting, receiving, or delivering samples are allowed
- Indicate in the Budget Justification the purpose of any travel, including the number of trips involved, the destinations, and the number of individuals for whom funds are requested
- When applicable, note the *institutional mileage* reimbursement rate in the Budget Justification
- Travel expenses to attend national, international, professional research or educational conferences are not allowed



Patient Costs

- Costs specifically required to conduct the research – which will not continue after the research project ends – are allowed
- Patient costs cannot include travel, lodging, or subsistence
- Usual and customary treatment costs are not allowed
- Patient costs must be thoroughly explained in the Budget Justification



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Cancer and Smoking Disease Research RFP – Budget

Contractual or Third-Party

- Contractual or third-party costs include personnel, supplies and any other allowable expense for the independent conduct of a portion of the work described in the Research Plan
- Contractual or third-party costs must be thoroughly explained in the Budget Justification
- Subcontracting for all necessary services with a single entity to implement the research project is not allowed. Indirect costs are not allowed.

Other Expenses

- Other expenses include postage, data processing, and other operating expenses not previously captured
- The cost of publishing the research findings in a scientific journal are allowable up to \$1,000
- Other expenses must be thoroughly explained in the Budget Justification
- If core services are utilized, note the number of hours and cost per hour for each core service in the Budget Justification
- Telephone and cell phone costs are not allowed
- Indirect or overhead costs, such as rent and utilities, are not allowed

- For Key Personnel listed on application page 3
- Limited two pages each



Cancer and Smoking Disease Research RFP - Other Support

- Principal Investigator only
- Content
 - Project Number
 - Source
 - Abstract
 - Change: Include a link to the abstract for each active and pending project, subproject, or subcontract
 - Dates of Approved/Proposed Project
 - · Annual Direct Costs
 - Percent of Effort
 - Overlap (if any)



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Cancer and Smoking Disease Research RFP – Letters

Letter of Support

- · From department chair or supervisor confirming
 - PI's faculty level appointment
 - Amount of laboratory space assigned to PI
 - PI's eligibility to apply for federal grants
- · PI cannot sign their own LOS

Letters of Collaboration

 If proposed work relies on collaboration with other researchers at other institutions or companies, and the individuals are not listed as key personnel

Letter must be legible but do not need to meet the margin and font requirements.

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Cancer and Smoking Disease Research RFP – Research Plan

Introduction (revised applications only)

- Summarize any substantial changes
- Include responses to weaknesses noted on the previous application review
- Highlight the changes within the text of the Research Plan by bracketing or italicizing
- Incorporate in the Preliminary Results section of the Research Plan any work done since the previous application was submitted
- An application can be revised a maximum of two times
- A revised application will not be considered for funding if substantial revisions are not clearly indicated



Cancer and Smoking Disease Research RFP – Appendix

- Optional
- Cannot be used to circumvent five-page limit of the Research Plan
- · Combine all Appendix material into one PDF document
- Save Appendix file as "LastName, FirstName of Principal Investigator – Appendix"
 - Example: Smith, Mary Appendix
- · Include a Table of Contents
- Does not require page numbering
- Possible content
 - Titles and complete references to appropriate publications and manuscripts accepted for publication
 - Publications or other printed materials documenting preliminary studies
 - Full-sized versions of photographs, tables, and graphs included in the research plan
